##### Calendar App

We added two-way integration with a Google calendar to the Schoolwires Calendar App. When you create an event in either calendar, that event and all its supported details is synced to the other calendar. ### Table App

We have added a Table App to our App Collection. The Table App allows you to easily create adaptive tables on your pages. The optional table summary complies with ADA requirements but does not display on your website. You can enter text into table cells and apply attributes to the text such as bold and underline. You can insert images, bulleted and numbered lists and links within a cell.

Location	Display Rules
Over the Middle of the Street	<p>It should be suspended vertically.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Union to the north in an east and west street or</li><li>• Union to the east in a north and south street.</li></ul>
Suspended over a Sidewalk	<p>The flag may be suspended from a rope extending from a house to a pole at the edge of the sidewalk.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The flag should be hoisted out from the building</li><li>• Union first</li></ul>
Flying the Flag at Half Staff	<p>Flying the flag at Half Staff means lowering the flag to one-half the distance between the top and bottom of the staff.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Should be first hoisted to the peak for an instant and then lowered to the half-staff position.</li><li>2. The flag should be again raised to the peak before it is lowered for the day.</li></ol> <p>Crepe streamers may be affixed to spear heads or flagstaffs in a parade only by order of the President of the United States.</p>

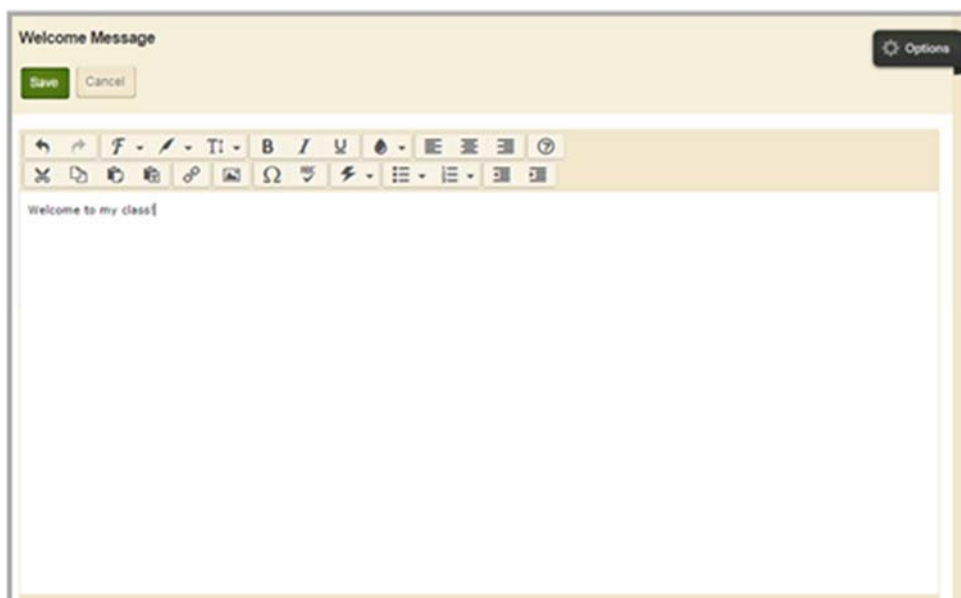
